

Flipped Classroom with Mrs. Garcia!!



1. Log onto www.agarciamath.weebly.com using any internet device.
(smartphone, laptop, notebook, tablet, iPad, computer, etc.)

*Computers in the library are available before/after school and during Rebelations.
2. Click on the corresponding tab for your class. Then click on tab for the corresponding 6 weeks grading period that we are in.
3. View the calendar and find the corresponding homework video.
4. Watch the **Lesson Video** and take **THOROUGH Notes**.
(Your notes should look **JUST LIKE MINE**. Pause/Rewind video when necessary.)
5. You must watch the **Lesson Video** and have the notes by **7:25 am**, on the day it is due.
(You need to email or speak to me, before school, if you did not watch last night's video.)
6. The purpose of the **Video Lesson** is to give you the basic information and skills you will need, on each topic, in order to be prepared to work, in class, the next day.
 - * **DON'T WORRY** if you do not completely understand all of the material when you watch the video... that's what I'm here for!
 - * Come to class with a complete set of notes and any questions that you have. Some days, I will spend the first part of class answering questions AND giving further explanations/examples.
7. During class, we will work independently, with partners, and in groups to complete Assignments and Activities over the topics covered in the previous night's **Video Lesson**.
 - * I will be right there, working in class with you, the whole time! I will answer questions that pop up and guide you through the difficult concepts, especially when you get stuck!
 - * You will gain a deeper understanding of the concepts because we will have time in class to work, as a team, to learn the material.
8. If you are **ABSENT**, you are still required to watch the **Video Lessons** and take the **Notes**, before you return to school.
9. The **Assignment/Activity** will be attached to my website and/or in the absent work folder when you return.
